Validity: That it evaluates or measures what and how it is supposed to

Reliability: consistency in results

Accountability: Those reviewing are responsible for their work

Fairness: Evaluations that are non-biased and evaluate in a way that actually reflects knowledge and

Shared Standards

Validity vs Utility

Both denote a goal or target

Reliability vs Accuracy

proper data collection and consistency. Both aim for strong results and measurement

Fairness vs Propriety

Both speak to a moral, legal or ethical standard

Program Evaluation

Utility: That the evaluation has a use

Accuracy: The data collection is reliable and rigorous

Propriety: Respects the law, without discrimination
